




FishMap Môn is a pioneering project developed by CCW in collaboration with the fishing industry that will help shape a sustainable future for fisheries and marine wildlife in Wales. This project is being trialled for the area around Anglesey, encompassing Porth Dinllaen and the Great Orme and runs until September 2012.

The aim of the project is to gather information from individual fishermen on fishing activity. This will result in maps that will provide a clear picture of the type and level of fishing activities taking place around Anglesey.

Information collected during this project will be combined with existing knowledge about the marine habitats and their sensitivity to fishing activities.

But where are the different fishing activities actually taking place?

Finding out more about fishing activities will help us to identify areas which are robust to particular fishing activities and others which are more vulnerable. This will enable fisheries around Anglesey to be managed more sustainably for future generations. Information collected during this project will be combined with existing knowledge about the marine habitats and their sensitivity to fishing activities.




